<b>Judges</b>	Norrie McLean      Keith Powell
<b>Rules</b>	<p>The tournament will be held under current GNAS rules including the use of alternative shooting colours registered and approved by GNAS.</p> <p>Proof of GNAS membership <b>WILL</b> be required.</p> <p>In accordance with Rule 304(f)(ii) all ends will be timed. 4 minutes for 6 arrows. Each end will be shot with 6 arrows</p>
<b>Trophies</b>	<p>Trophies are only awarded to archers shooting the rounds for which they are eligible or a higher than specified round for that age group, e.g. a 15 year old lady entering for a Bristol II, they will not be eligible for trophy/medal in their age group, i.e. Bristol III.</p> <p>Second and third places will be awarded according to entry.</p>
<b>NOVICE COMPETITION.</b>	Those archers entering the novice competition are advised to be at the field ready to shoot for 1230 hrs. The starting time for the afternoon rounds will be at the judge's discretion
<b>DRUG TESTING:</b>	This shoot could be drug tested and competitors approached for samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. To this end a parent's or guardian's signature must be provided on the entry form for all competitors who are under 18.
<b>NOVICE:</b>	Is defined as an archer who is in his or her first affiliated season with GNAS, provided that he or she has not been affiliated to any other British or FITA affiliated body. The Novice Trophies will be awarded to those who are 21 or over for the National round unless an alternative round, agreed prior to the shoot commences, is acceptable to all parties.
<b>CHILD AND VULNERABLE ADULT PROTECTION – PHOTOGRAPHY</b>	Any person wishing to take photographs/video of the event are required to register with the tournament organiser prior to taking such images. Where a person is found to be taking such images without registering they will be required to erase any images taken.
<b>CHILD PROTECTION</b>	Where an archer under 18 yrs of age attends the competition without their parent/guardian being present (i.e. travels with another archer) the organiser should be informed on the day of the competition who is responsible for the archer.
<b>PLEASE NOTE:</b>	There are no refreshment facilities at the event, please bring your own lunch.
<b>All current trophy holders are requested to return or arrange for the trophies to be returned (cleaned) on or before the day of the competition.</b>
